Slaughter steers and heifers closed the period preceding the Thanksgiving holiday week steady to 1.00 lower. Full decline on

heifers. Early week sharp declines were mostly recovered on Tuesday and Wednesday. Midweek advances registered at wholesale beef level added more impetus to trading and demand at late week. Slaughter cows 1.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 1.00-2.00 lower.

Estimated 5 day receipts this week 6600 compared to actuals last week of 6693 and 6423 last year. Slaughter steers accounting for 38 percent of receipts, slaughter heifers 33 percent, slaughter cows 10 percent and feeder cattle 17 percent.
