NEW YORK, N.Y. — The Market Administrator has announced informational meetings to discuss the expansion of Federal Order No. 2 into northeastern Pennsylvania effective December 1.

These meetings are intended to provide guidance to handlers and juggers who will become subject to

the Order. Anyone within the expanded marketing area who bottles and sells milk to consumers (or contemplates doing this) is urged to attend. The meetings will not be of particular interest to milk producers who sell their milk in bulk.

The schedule of meetings is as follows:

Monday, November 25, Holiday Inn Sunbury-Selinsgrove; 10 a.m. Routes 11 & 15, Shamokin Dam;

Tuesday, November 26, The Inn at Nichols Village, 10 a.m., Routes 6 & 11, Clarks Summit.

Members of the Market Administrator's staff will be available to answer questions and to provide instructions for complying with the Order.
