USDA raises tobacco fees

The U.S.

Department of Agriculture has increased the fees it charges for voluntary tabacco inspection performed by department personnel, a USDA official announced. Lioniel Edwards, a marketing official with USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service, said the hourly rate for tobacco inspection during regular working hours will in-crease from \$20.45 to \$22.30. Fees for overtime service will increase from \$24.40 to \$26.60 an hour, and service performed on Sundays and

holidays will be raised from \$30.50

Edwards said the increases will take effect Nov. 4, and will not affect the mandatory inspection fees for sales at designated auction markets.

Under terms of the Tobacco Inspection Act, fees must, as nearly as practicable, cover the costs of inspection services. Edwards said congressionally authorized salary increases and costs of workers' and unem-ployment compensation were the biggest factors contributing to the latest increase.
