Ground-driven tillage tool unveiled

MENDOTA, IL — A ground-driven tillage tool, called Dyna-Drive is now available from Hart-Carter Combany.

Dyna-Drive utilizes twin rotors, each operating at a different speed to provide optimum soil conditioning for an ideal, well-drained, weather-protected seedbed. No PTO or gear box is required.

The unit is a close following tillage tool that leaves a seedbed

exceptionally level with uniform tilth and fewer and smaller clods than a disc/harrow or field cultivator. Dyna-Drive should reduce fuel costs and mean less strain on tractor. Depending on soil conditions, one-pass tillage is

very possible.

Dyna-Drive features twin rotors with paddle-shaped tines in a spiral pattern spaced every 4 1/2", resulting in ground contact every 2 1/4". The front tines rotate at

about one-half ground speed. This provides a lifting and soil fracturing action. The rear tines rotate three times faster than the front, breaking up clods—leaving an ideal seedbed for planting.

Models range from 7 to 15 feet in working width. Working depth is adjustable from 1 1/2 to 5 1.2". A crumbler roller (see photo) is standard equipment.


