CUMBERLAND COUNTY DHIA Monthly Report

October, 1985


Cumberland County Dairy Herd Improvement records show that 5,171 cows in 84 herds were on production testing in October according to Duane G. Duncan, County Agent. Of the 68 herds on DHIA, 35 herds have an average fat production of 600 pounds. During the month 83 completed their 305 lactation with 650 lbs of butterfat. DGIA Supervisors working with the dairymen to improve efficiency include Harold Boldosser, 130 Old Gap Road, Carlisle, PA; John Rolar, R#2, Box 97, Newville, PA; Owen McCulloch, R#2, Box 333, Newville, PA; and Shane Henry, R#3, Newville, PA. 




← Inside Feeding Alley




