who have been "qualified" by USDA to receive promotion assessment funds in Pennsylvania are Inter-State Milk Producers Cooperative and Atlantic Dairy Association, both in Southampton.

Other choices for Order 4 dairymen include the New Jersey Dairy Industry Advisory Council and the South Jersey Dairy Industry Advisory Council, both located in Trenton, NJ; the Dairy Food and Nutrition Council, Inc., in Cedar Knolls, NJ; the Dairy Council of Greater Metropolitan Washington, Inc., in Bethesda, MD; and the Dairy Council of Upper Chesapeake Bay, Inc., in Towson.
