After we tobacco growers have enough pounds of Type 609, we will be able to attract larger buyers at our auction. There are currently several middle men that our tobacco moves through before it reaches the processors. We need all these buyers now. Remember, tobacco buyers are not any different than your milk inspector. They want a good product. It's up to you growers to do the job.  
**PREPARATION:** Lots will consist of 11 Tennessee Style Bales and 15 Pa Style Bales (50-70 lbs.) It is very important and will eliminate many problems if you keep your lots very consistent. One bale will be exposed on each lot for buyer inspection. That bale MUST represent all the bales on that lot! Keep pole burned tobacco in a separate lot. Keep the green out of your tobacco. DO NOT strip your tobacco too damp. When storing tobacco on the farm, stack your bales so that all sides of the bale are exposed to the air.
