Trading slow to moderate on moderate supply. Pre-holiday demand moderate from most buying interests. Yields generally less than buyer expectations. Slaughter steers closed weak to 1.00 lower, except holstein steers firm to 1.00 higher. Slaughter heifers 1.00 to 1.50 lower. Cows mostly 1.00-3.00 higher. Bulls firm to 1.00 higher. Supply mainly good to average choice slaughter steers and heifers with 12% cows. Estimated receipts this week about 2200 as compared to 2230 a week ago and 2250 a year ago.
