Slaughter steers and heifers this holiday shortened week closed steady to .50 higher. This advance posted at early week as a light run was met with a good demand by 1 to 2 local packer buyers. A strengthening in wholesale beef prices was the dominant factor for the advance this week. Slaughter cows .50-2.00 higher for the week, Slaughter Bulls steady.

Estimated 4 day receipts this week 3,100 compared to 5 day actual receipts last week of 8144 and 4 day actual receipts last year 4119. Slaughter Steers accounted for 36 percent of the week's receipts, Slaughter Heifers 40 percent, Slaughter Cows 20 percent and Feeder Cattle 2 percent.
