Central U.S. Carlot Beef Report Includes The Major Production Areas In The Midwest, Texas, And Oklahoma. As Of 4:00 P.M.

Compared to Wednesday's 4:00 P.M. report: Steer carcasses steady; Heifers steady to \$1.00 lower, decline on heavy choice. Demand and movement good at current price levels on moderate supplies with bulk of sales early. Consecutive days of declining prices.

The gross boxed beef carcass cutout value declined \$.07 to an estimated \$98.08 per cwt, 295 loads boxed cuts reported.

Sales reported on 54 loads of steer and heifer carcasses.

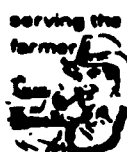

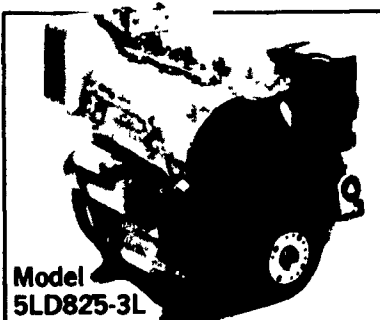
