He has served his chapter as second chaplain, and is chapter and Lancaster County reporter this year. James has also chaired a number of committees.

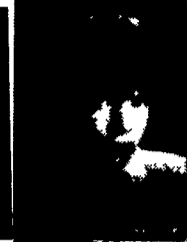
He plans to major in agricultural science at Penn State.
