### CECIL COUNTY DHIA November, 1985

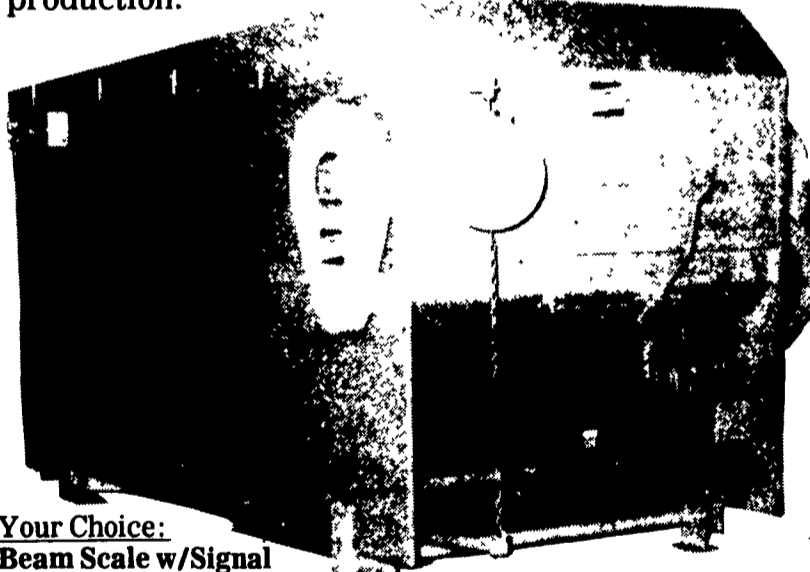
