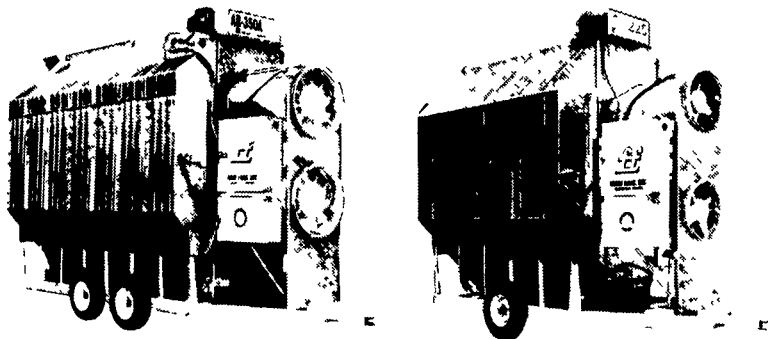
The gates are shipped with the mechanical and electrical parts pre-assembled at the factory. You cut the rails to the exact length needed.

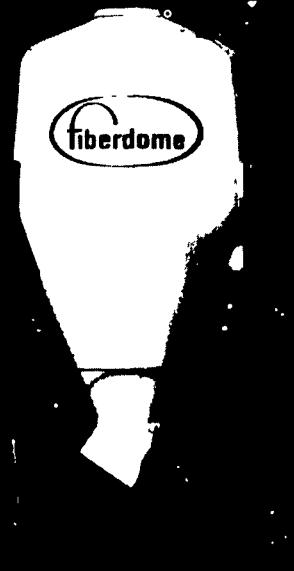
