

## Low-cost beam scale now available for batch mixers

BARRINGTON, IL — An economical beam-type scale is now available for two popular batch mixers from A. O. Smith-Harvestore Products, Inc. The beam scale may be selected as a lower-cost alternative to a dial-type scale on the model 420 and model 441 batch mixers.

With capacity up to 4,500 lbs. and accuracy to one-half percent, the beam scale is similar to the

familiar livestock and platform scales. Hardened and plated balance knife edges contribute to long-term reliability.

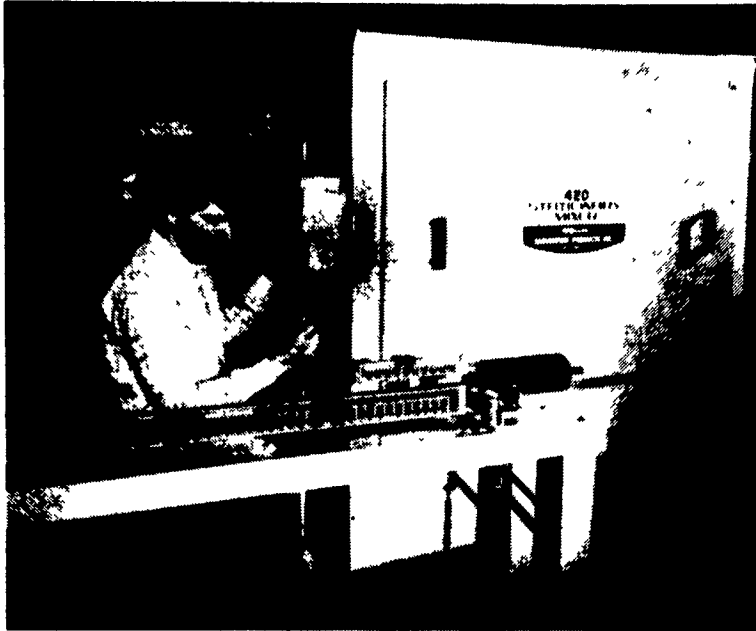
The scale bench measures 66 in. long by 9 in. wide and stands 46 in. high. It may be placed at any corner of the batch mixer and positioned at various angles for

maximum flexibility in feedroom layout.

The scale has a main beam calibrated in 100 lb. increments and a find adjustment beam that measures up to 100 lbs. in 1 lb. increments.

A cut-off switch is located at the free-swinging end of the main beam. The switch, which senses when the scale is in balance, may be used to turn off conveyors and unloaders when a preset amount of feed has been delivered to the

The beam scale can be replaced by a dial indicator without changing the lever system, so livestock and dairy farmers can choose the less expensive beam scale now, then upgrade the system later.



A new beam scale is now available as an option on model 420 and 441 batch mixers from A. O. Smith Harvestore Products, Inc. The beam scale, similar to those used for trade, is a lower cost alternative to a dial-type scale. The scale bench can be positioned at any one of the mixer's four corners and at a variety of angles, so it's easy to fit into existing facilities. The scale weighs up to 4,500 lbs. in 1 lb. increments.

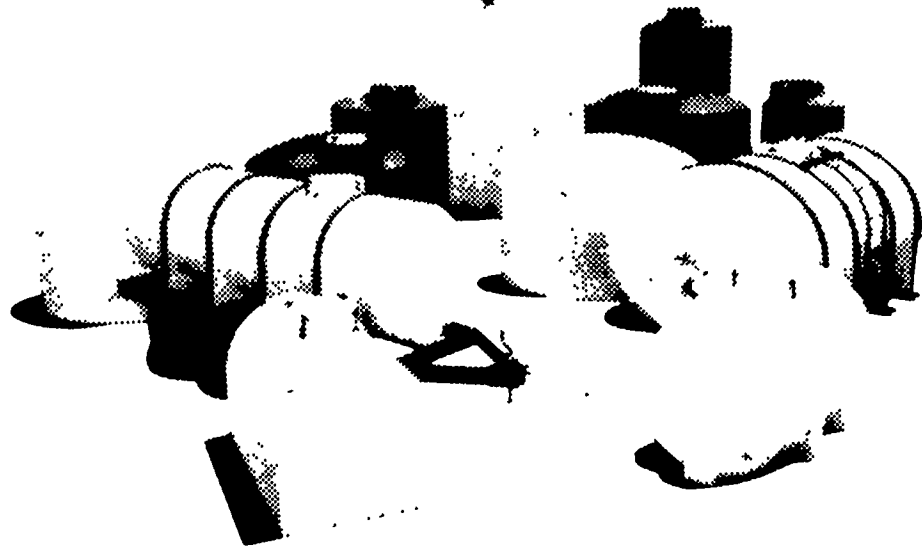
