Swine breeders honor Henkel

In addition to raising Yorkshires for breeding stock and research purposes, Henkel was instrumental in the formation of the Keystone Pork Congress (this year scheduled for Feb. 20 at Harrisburg's Penn Harris Motor Inn) and is a past member of the board of directors of the National Pork Council.

Henkel recently stepped down after a two-year term as president of the Pennsylvania Livestock Association. At present, he serves as a director of the Pennsylvania Pork Producers Council, and represents the state on the National Pseudorabies Oversight Committee.

Henkel was named one of the state's Master Farmers in 1961.






