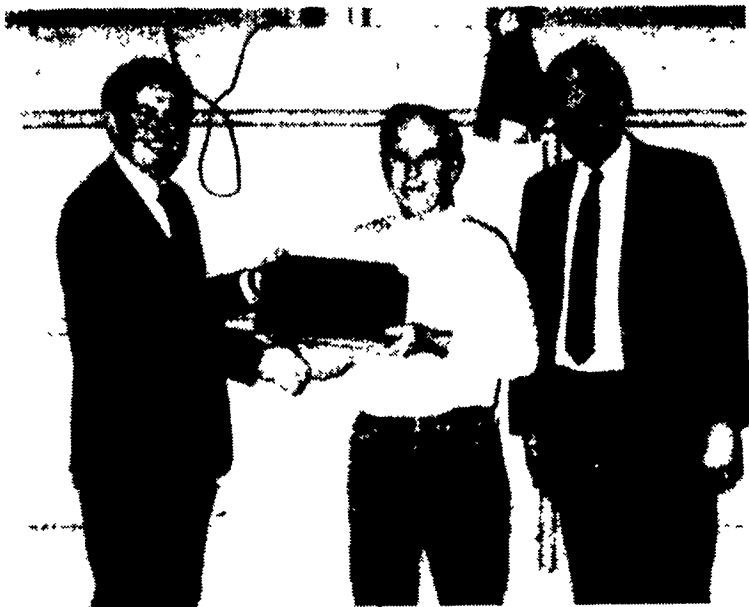


Swine breeders honor Henkel

HARRISBURG — In addition to selling their Farm Show bred gilt champions on Monday, the state's purebred swine breeders took time out to honor Strasburg pork producer John Henkel for his outstanding leadership and contributions to the swine industry. Dennis Grumbine, president of the Pennsylvania Swine Breeders Co-op, presented Henkel with the organization's annual Pennsylvania Swine Co-op Award. In addition to raising Yorkshires for breeding stock and research purposes, Henkel was instrumental in the formation of the

Keystone Pork Congress (this year scheduled for Feb. 20 at Harrisburg's Penn Harris Motor Inn) and is a past member of the board of directors of the National Pork Council. Henkel recently stepped down after a two-year term as president of the Pennsylvania Livestock Association. At present, he serves as a director of the Pennsylvania Pork Producers Council, and represents the state on the National Pseudorabies Oversight Committee. Henkel was named one of the state's Master Farmers in 1981.

Five-Acre Corn Club honors growers

HARRISBURG — State corn growers who produced the highest yields in the machine and hand harvest divisions of the 1985 Pennsylvania Five-Acre Corn Club were honored during the 70th Farm Show in Harrisburg. Winners were announced by State Agriculture Secretary Richard Grubb at the annual meeting of the Master Corn Growers Association, yesterday. Paul McPherson of RD 1, New Park, YORK COUNTY, was champion of the shelled grain regular harvest class. Joseph Stump, RD 1, YORK, was second and David Chilcote of Chilcote and Peters, Stewartstown, YORK COUNTY, was third.

Winner of the ear corn regular harvest class was Snyder Valley Farm of RD 1, Parker, CLARION COUNTY. Runnerup was Bruce Bivens of FULTON COUNTY followed by Burd Schantz of Alburts, BERKS COUNTY.

Thomas C. Dunlap of RD 4, Jersey Shore, CLINTON COUNTY, won the shelled grain - 3 acre plus harvest class. He was followed by Richard Kreider of LEBANON and Richard Fetterman of Catawissa, COLUMBIA COUNTY.

Wayne Reymeyer of RD 1, New Freedom, YORK COUNTY, won the shelled grain, regular harvest class. John Cooper of BEAVER COUNTY was second, while John McDowell of MERCER COUNTY was third.

Richard Snyder of RD 1, Montoursville, LYCOMING COUNTY, won the shelled grain, 3 acre plus harvest class, followed by Kervin Zimmerman of LEBANON COUNTY and Glenn Studebaker of BUTLER COUNTY. Winner of the ear corn, regular harvest class was Rodger Nordmeyer of RD 3, Saylorsburg, MONROE COUNTY, while Lew Pickel of LAWRENCE COUNTY placed second and Eugene Graham of BUTLER COUNTY was third.
