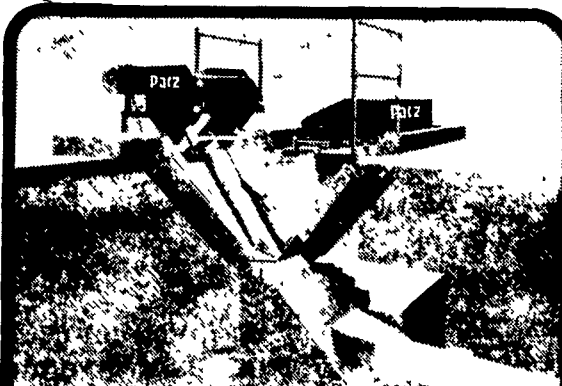

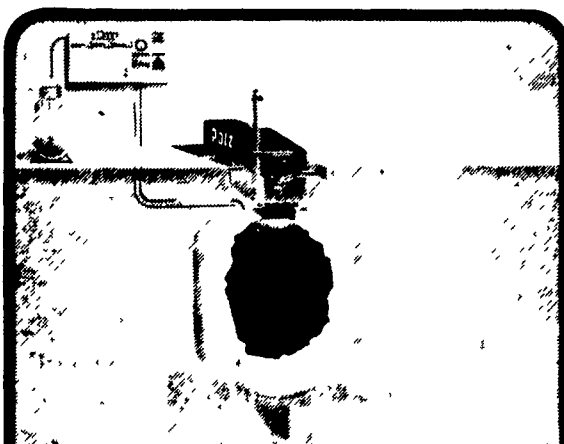

For slurry manure: Patz Model 100 Slurry Pump

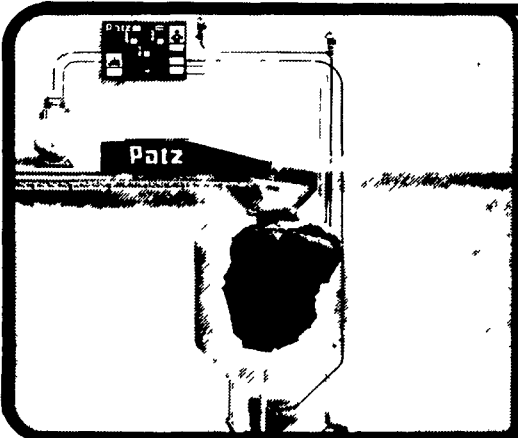
- Handle high volumes of free-flowing manure or slurry with fine-cut bedding.

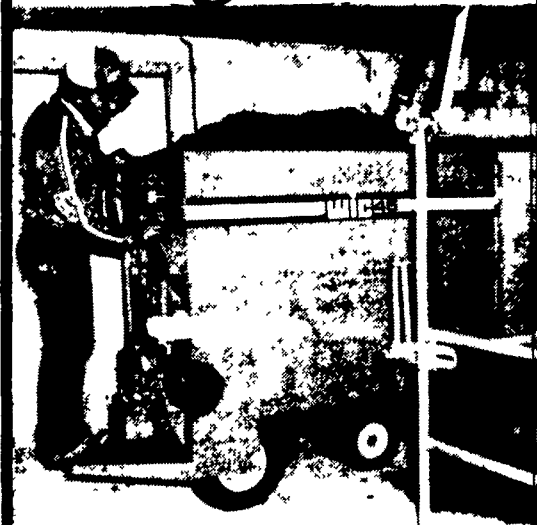
