

## CCC revises cheese price Since April 1, 1985, the CCC

WASHINGTON - The U.S. Department of Agriculture has announced an increase in the Commodity Credit Corporation purchase price for cheese.

Section 103 of the Food Security Act of 1985, signed by the President Dec. 23 prohibits the Secretary from taking any market value of whey into consideration for the purposes of supporting the price of purchase price for cheese have been based on the projected whey powder return of one cent per pound for manufactured cheese. As a result of eliminating consideration of the whey powder return, the purchase prices for cheddar cheese produced on or after Dec. 23 are increased one cent per pound — to \$1.25 per pound for 40-pound blocks and \$1.2075 per pound for 500-pound barrels. The CCC purchase prices for

butter and nonfat dry milk remain unchanged from those announced June 26, 1985.


The Food Security Act also establishes the support price for milk at \$11.60 per hundredweight for the period Jan. 1, 1986, through Dec. 31, 1986. This price has been in effect since July 1, 1985
