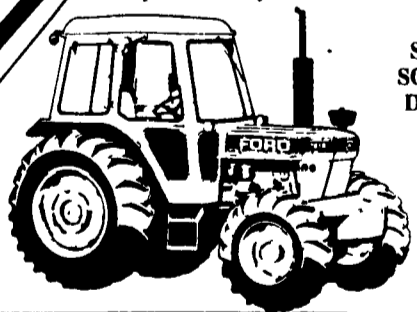

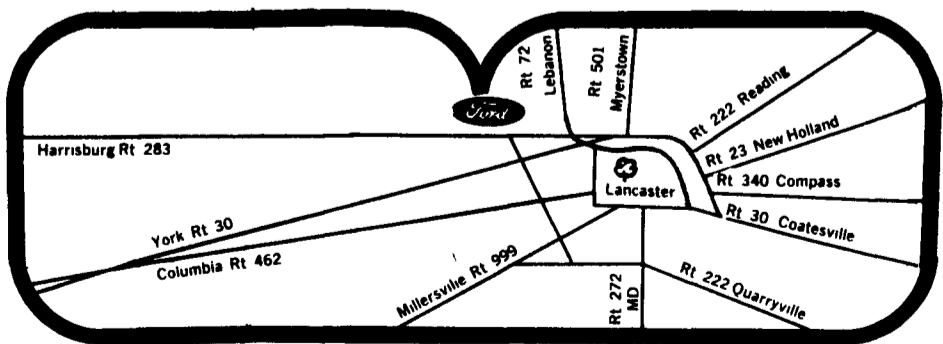

LANCASTER — The Guernsey Sales Pavilion was the site for the 334th special Guernsey sale, on Jan. 23. Top selling cow of the sale was Galaxies Choice Lisa, a three year old consigned by Rodney L. Fritz, Narvon. She was purchased for \$1075 by Jonas Zook, Myerstown.

Second high selling cow was Greystone Cyclone Florette, a three year old cow consigned by John B. Merryman, Sparks, MD. Jonas Zook also purchased this cow.

Zook currently owns a part Guernsey, part Holstein herd. He purchased seven head at this sale with plans to eventually develop an

The total number of animals sold was 38, with prices ranging from \$1075 to \$100. The average for the sale was \$577.50. The total for all animals sold was \$21,945.

The new statute gives the Secretary the authority to accept or reject any or all bids.

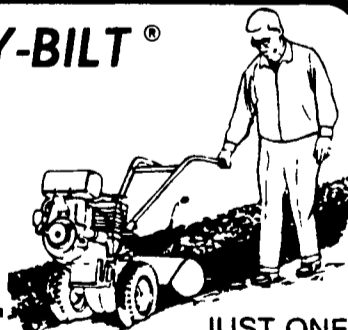
Successful bidders will be given the following options for receiving payments:

- Equal annual payments.
- No payment for first year. Thereafter, the producer has

the option of equal annual payments or a payment not to exceed 85 percent of the contract amount for the second year, with the remainder of the payment made equally in annual payments.

- Payment in the first year not to exceed 80 percent. Thereafter, the remainder will be paid in equal annual installments.
