



The new statute gives the Secretary the authority to accept or reject any or all bids.

Successful bidders will be given the following options for receiving payments:

• Equal annual payments.

No payment for first year.
Thereafter, the producer has

the option of equal annual payments or a payment not to exceed 85 percent of the contract amount for the second year, with the remainder of the payment made equally in annual payments.

• Payment in the first year not to exceed 80 percent. Thereafter, the remainder will be paid in equal annual installments.
