
Pennsylvania FFA'ers receive Keystone Degrees




She has been a member of the Junior Prom Committee and participated in Penn State '85 and attended the Kansas City Convention in 1985.

At present, Mike works for his father and grandfather on the family's dairy farm.


Some of Mike's FFA activities have included parliamentary procedure, land judging, FFA week, membership in various committees and livestock showing.

dent at W.B. Saul High School, Steven has been a member of the Philadelphia FFA Chapter for four vears.




He has participated in the flower show, fruit sale, junior flower show, and farm show. He has attended the State and National Conventions and served on the Prom Committee.


