Overall finish continued fairly attractive, particularly on heifers and mud only a minimal problem. Cows 3.00-4.00 higher. Bulls 1.00-2.00 higher.

Estimated 5 day receipts 6000; actuals last week 5,779; year ago 9,254. Steers comprised 45 percent of the week's receipts, heifers 41 percent, cows 8 percent, feeders 5 percent.
