below the close of a week ago,

finishing the period at the lowest level since October 1985. A sharply lower wholesale beef trade, along with a sluggish product movement proved the prime factors in the decline. Overall finish appeared less attractive than recent weeks, while mud a minimal problem. Slaughter cows 2.00-4.00 lower. Bulls near steady.

Estimated 5 day receipts 6250; actuals last week 5868; last year 9254. Steers comprised 44 percent of week's receipts; heifers comprised 41 percent; cows 9 percent, feeders 5 percent.

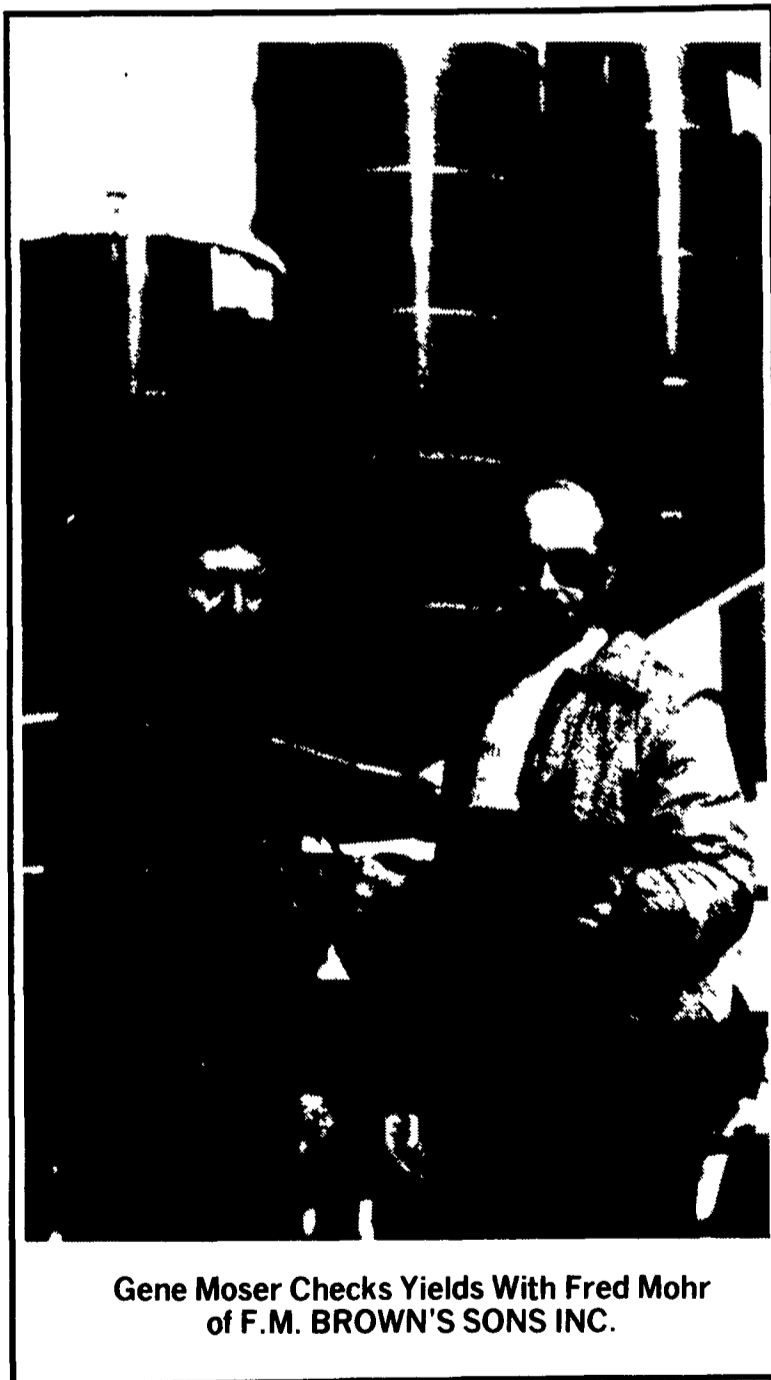
