A large country movement along with broad declines in wholesale beef levels precipitated the downturn. Overall finish continued fairly attractive, while numbers of 'muddy' cattle some what increased. Slaughter cows 1.50-2.00 higher. Bulls fully steady.

Estimated 5 day receipts 5600; actuals last week 5953; last year 6736. Steers comprised 42 percent of week's receipts; heifers 42 percent cows 10 percent, feeders 5 percent.




