Trading moderate on light supply. Demand light to moderate. Slaughter steers mostly steady; heifers weak to 1.00 lower. All sales early with insufficient volume after Monday for a market test. Cows uneven, generally steady. Bulls weak to 2.00 lower. Supply mainly good to low choice slaughter steers and heifers with 12% cows. Estimated receipts this week about 1100 compared with actual weights receipts of 1107 last week and 969 a year ago.




