

Clothing, Textiles Masters Program offered

LEESPORT - Are you interested in updating your sewing knowledge, increasing your shopping skills, or learning more about wardrobe and color coordination? Would you be willing to share your skills with others in return for training? If so, then you may be interested in the new Clothing and Textiles Masters program being offered by Penn State University Extension Service.

Clothing and textiles masters are volunteers who are trained by

professional Extension staff and resource persons. In exchange for 30 hours of free training, the clothing and textiles master "pays back" 40 hours of volunteer time to the Extension Service in their respective county within one year. Volunteers may select from a variety of activities.

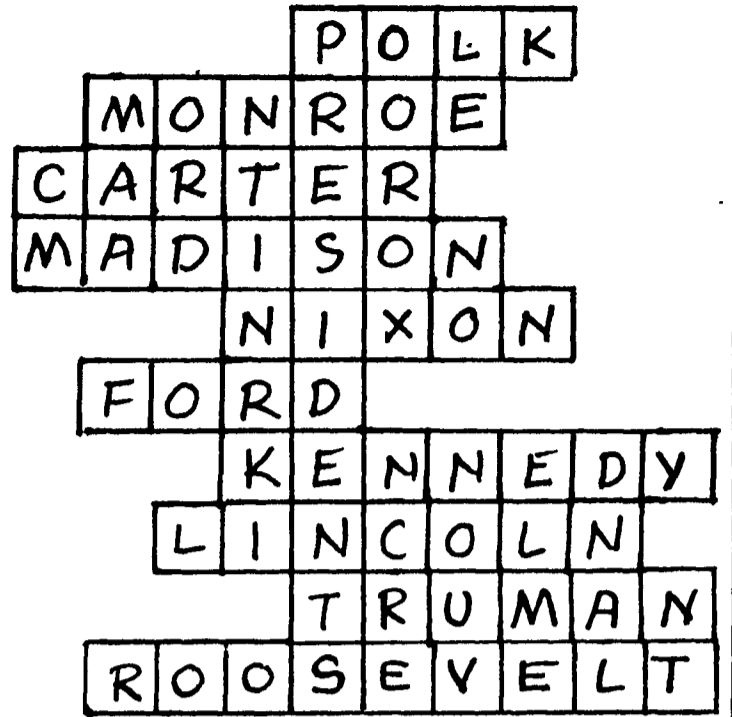
Each person taking the course will receive up-to-date, in-depth, and hands-on training and information in the field of clothing and textiles. In addition, each

person will receive a resource notebook and a certificate of completion and continuing education credits from Penn State University.

This program is similar to the Master Gardener and Master Knitter programs which have been so successful in extending the Extension Services resources. Volunteer payback activities include working with 4-H clothing leaders, planning related clothing activities such as 4-H Fashion Revue, preparing learning packets, recruiting other volunteer leaders, answering clothing and textiles related questions in the Extension office, and teaching adult/youth workshops.

Interested adults are eligible to apply for the clothing and textiles masters program. Job descriptions and applications are available by contacting Berks County Extension Office, Berks County Ag Center, Leesport, PA 19533. 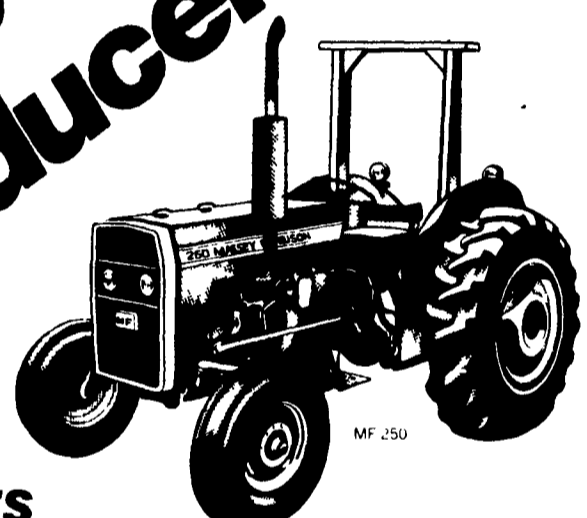
