



# Farmers encouraged to participate in grain storage survey

LEESPORT — Donald E. Lutz, chairman of the Berks County ASC Committee, said large grain and oilseed supplies necessitated the farm storage capacity survey currently being conducted by the U S Department of Agriculture to determine available and potentially available storage space in different areas of the country

"Survey forms have been mailed to 1,752 farm operators and other entities in Berks County with noncommercial storage," he said USDA policymakers will review the survey results and attempt to pinpoint where handling and storage problems could occur during harvest

To verify off-farm storage space, ASCS and the Statistical Reporting Service are jointly surveying commercial facilities

In 1978, U.S. on-farm storage was estimated at 9.95 billion bushels, according to Lutz. As of January 1, 1985, off-farm storage was estimated at 8.12 billion bushels

Lutz encourages farm operators to complete and return the survey form as soon as possible. The study will help determine storage capacity for permanent and temporary dry grain or oilseed crops, storage space for ear corn and the storage capacity for high moisture grain.
