HARRISBURG - The Penn- Rudman dairy cuts. These sylvania State Grange is in favor of proposed cuts would mean a loss of maintaining a price support level at least 40 cents per hundredweight of all milk produced starting March 1 until October 1.

State Master Charles E. Wismer said the Grange is opposed to the Gramm-Rudman cuts on behalf of the dairy farmers. "The dairy farmers would lose \$320 million between March and October with the Gramm-Rudman cuts," said Master Wismer. "These cuts are well over the 4.3 percent reduction of the commodity credit corporation," added Master Wismer.

As an alternative, the Grange recommends a maximum 10 cents hundredweight assessment on all milk produced This assessment would cover the

Gramm-Rudman mandate and amount to less than \$80 million

The Grange understands legislation will be introduced in Washington, D.C. this week which would authorize this approximate 10 cent assessment and plans to actively support this legislation, said Master Wismer.


