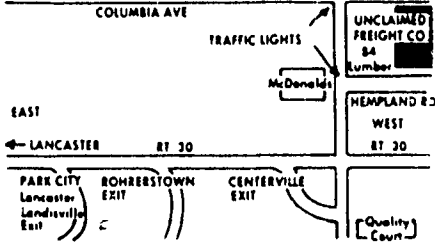

Chester County seeks dairy princess candidates

GAP — Chester County has begun its annual search for dairy princess candidates, who will compete during a contest on May 31.

All single young women between the ages of 16 and 22 who have a dairy farm background are eligible to compete for the title of 1986 Chester County Dairy princess.

Contestants must be the daughter of a dairy farmer in Chester County or own at least one dairy animal herself. She must have completed her junior year in high school and will not turn 22 before Dec. 31.

The dairy princess will be selected by a panel of three judges.

The judges base their decisions on appearance, speaking ability, poise, personality and knowledge of the dairy industry. She must also present a three to five minute presentation promoting dairy products.

The winner of the Chester County contest will attend a training seminar July 8 to 10 and compete in the state dairy princess pageant in Harrisburg, Sept. 18 through 20.
