Compared with last week, Slaughter Steers closed 1.00 to 1.50 lower; Heifers .50 to 1.00 lower. Demand light to moderate. Supply light with bulk of receipts Monday and too few receipts balance of the week for a market test. Steadily lower dressed beef prices coupled with increasing amounts of mud precipitated the decline in live cattle prices. Cows closed fully steady. Bulls firm to 2.00 higher. Supply mainly good to average choice slaughter steers and heifers

with 10/ cows. Estimated receipts this week 1000 compared with actual receipts of 1073 a week ago and 1251 a year ago.

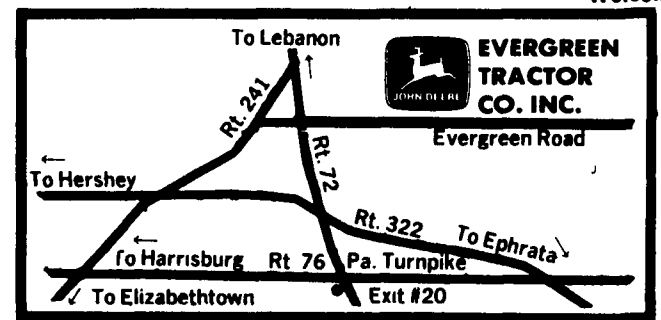

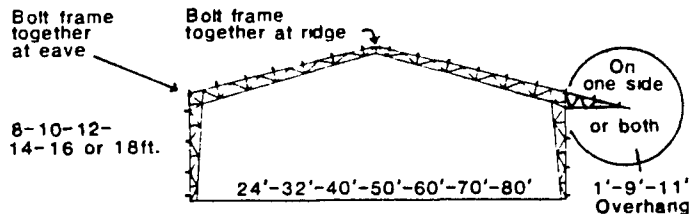

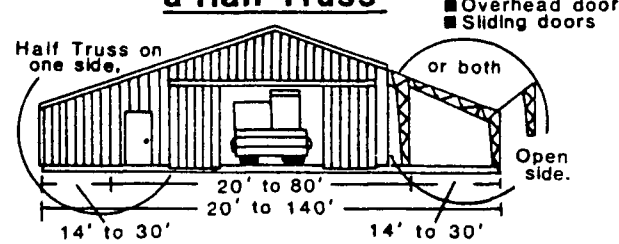
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
