The Busy Bee Workers 4-H Sewing Club of Millersburg held its organizational meeting March 10.

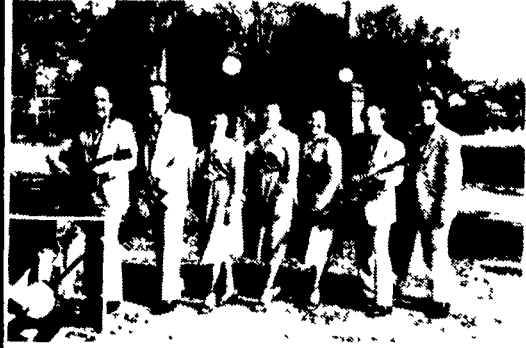

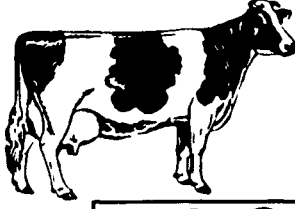

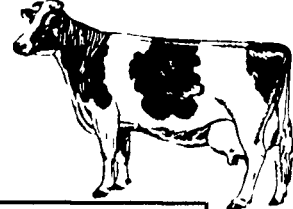
