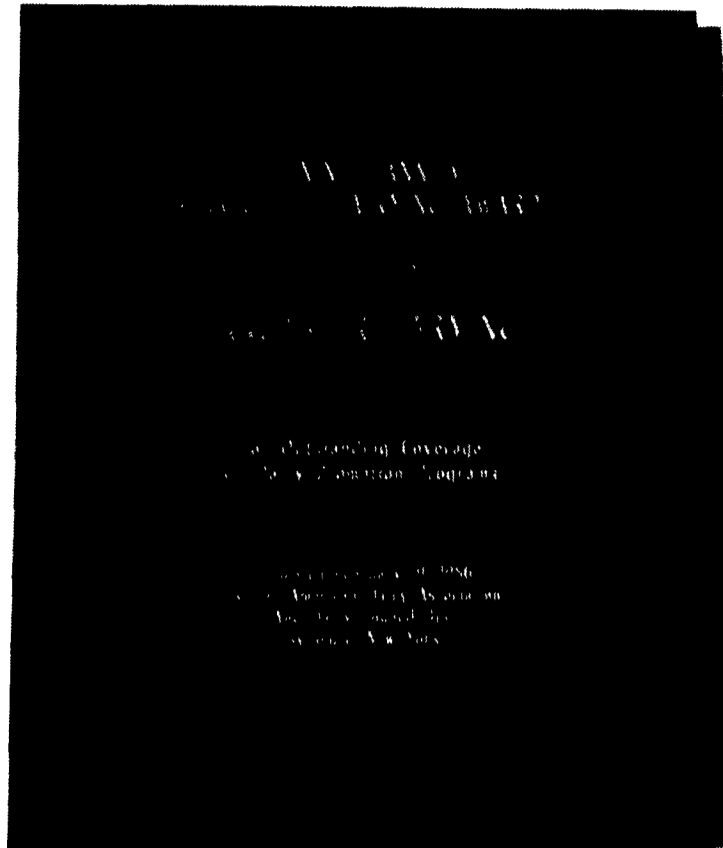


LANCASTER FARMING WINS DAIRY AWARD
