Slaughter steers and heifer prices advanced 1.50-2.50 over last weeks closing levels. Good buyer demand, prompted by a stronger dressed traded and higher prices for cattle from direct points were the dominant factors for this week's advance. Warm weather and spring breezes combining to dry feedlot pens and mud not as much of a problem as in recent weeks. Slaughter cows 3.00-4.00 lower. Slaughter Bulls steady.

Estimated 4 day receipts this holiday shortened week 6,300 compared to actuals last week of 5,152 and last year of 6,262. Slaughter Steers accounted for 50 percent of receipts, Slaughter Heifers 38 percent. Slaughter Cows 9 percent, Feeder Cattle 1 percent.
