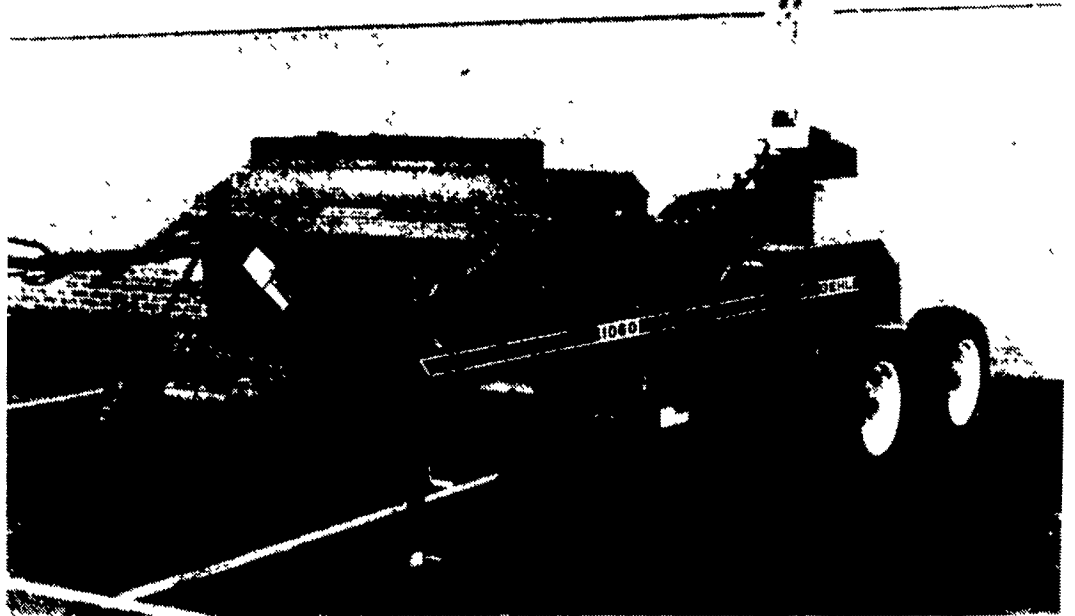
Stanley E. Bird, vice-president marketing for HOLSTEIN WORLD explains that "Upgrading

vancement (PGA) Sire Sampling system. Based on their outstanding pedigrees these young bulls have been selected as one of 150 Holstein bulls from throughout the United

States to enter the program in 1986.

7H3046 Len-Lyn Bova Anton-ET was bred by Galen Crouse, Stevens, Pennsylvania. He is sired by Rockalli Son of Bova, the breed's highest active PDM sire. The dam, Diamond-S Wapa Classy, is an Excellent (90-2E) Conductor daughter with a January 1986 cow index of + 913M + 48F + \$133.

Her first three records are all

over 4.0% test with a top record of 5-6 365d 27,640M 4.5% 1,250F. The grandam is a Very Good (86) Gold Medal dam with three records over 28,800M and 1,000 fat and lifetime credits of 143,120M 3.7% 5,232F. The next dam is also Excellent (93-3E) Gold Medal with records up to 28,702M and 1,139F.

7H3050 Earlyndell Quick Profit was bred by Earl S. Weaver, New Holland, Pennsylvania. He is sired

by Air-Osa Oak Quick Shot, one of Elevation's finest udder improving sons. The dam, Earlyndell Jack Heidi Dusty, is a Very Good (87) Walnut-Lane Admiral Jack daughter with a January 1986 cow index of + 1300M + 45F + \$151. She has been consistently a 4.0% tester with a fine four-year-old record of 26,510M 1,047F. The grandam also has over 1,000 fat with 29,533M as a five year old.




