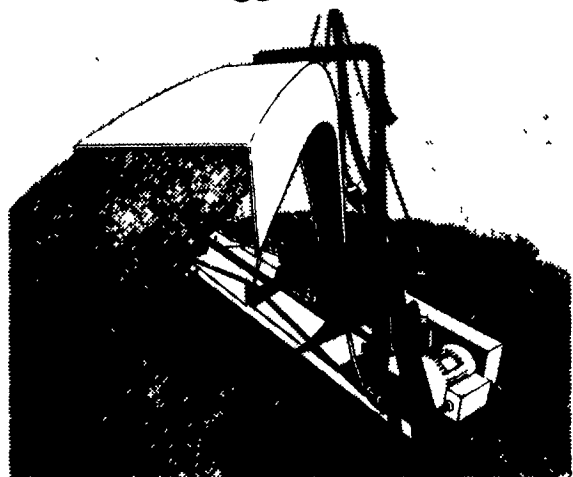

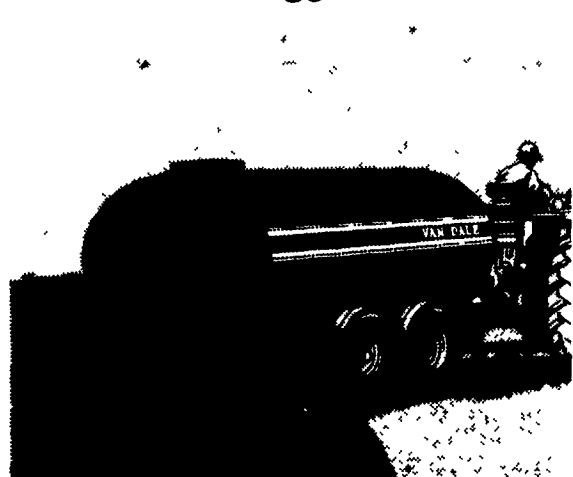
Performance for tough silo-unloading jobs:



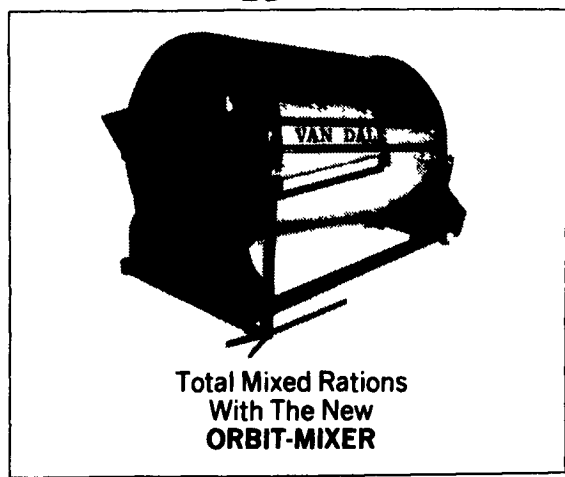
Performance for tough feed-distribution jobs:

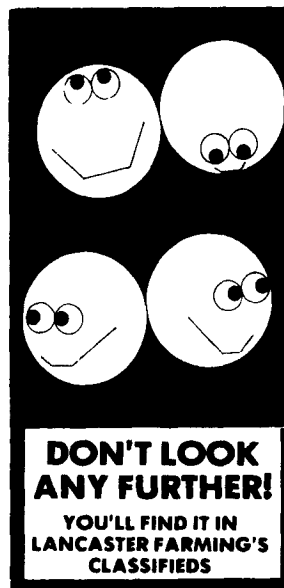
