The first story is improved by a kitchen, dining and living room, bedroom and one utility room. The second story is improved by 3 bedrooms and a bath. The dwelling is heated with oil baseboard hot water heat. One two-story utility building 12'x22' with a seamed metal roof and outside walls of corrugated metal. One steel and block hog finishing building approximately 30'x115'. The building is improved by 32 finishing pens with slatted floors and 7 ventilating fans. One frame hog farrowing house approximately 24'x120', roof and outside walls covered with corrugated aluminum roofing, improved with 18 metal farrowing pens, slatted floors and 4 ventilating fans.
