## Bourbon Springs to host 5th Spring Sale

NEWVILLE — Junior livestock exhibitors interested in finishing a prize-winning project lamb or pig for the coming show season may want to visit Cumberland County's Newville Fairgrounds on April 26. The occasion is Bourbon Springs Farm's fifth Spring Sale, which

will include guest consignors Lemmon Farm of Newburg and Shepherd's Crook of Mechanicsburg.

In addition to project animals, the sale will feature 25 bred gilts, 15 service-age boars and 20 open gilts.

Attracting buyers from several Pennsylvania counties, as well as Virginia, West Virginia, Maryland and New York, the Bourbon Springs sale has produced champions for many exhibitors on the local and county levels.

Something special this year, reports Bourbon Springs owners, Ken and Joann Ketterer, will be the sale of progeny of three Duroc boars that had sired high indexing pens of boars in three state boar tests last year. Bourbon Springs has been involved in the Meat Animal Evaluation Center boar test at State College since 1974.

Another Pennsylvania boar test regular is Lemmon Farm, owned by Bruce Lemmon and Bruce, Jr.. Last year Lemmon Farms had the top indexing pen of boars on test, and set new records for individual boar index (171) and loin eye area (7 square inches).

Shepherd's Crook owner Robert Leib is well known in sheep show circles for producing show winners. Shepherd's Crook has produced many market and purebred champions, including the 1984 Cumberland County FFA market champion.

Auctioneered by Art Kling, the sale is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. on April 26 at the Newville Fairgrounds, located on Route 533 west of Newville.

## Fencing bulletin published

NEWARK, DE — Good fencing is an important part of horse management. Horses can break out of weak fences, injuring or scarring themselves in the process. Fencing should be strong, safe, durable and attractive.

The Delaware Cooperative Extension Service has published a bulletin which discusses the types and construction of horse fences. The 28-page booklet includes chapters on planning and selecting fences, as well as detailed instructions for laying out fence lines and constructing post and rail, wire mesh, and board fences. Also

included are directions for building both floodgates and standard gates.

The bulletin is available for \$2 (payable to the University of Delaware) from the Extension Agricultural Engineer, Plan Service, 058 Townsend Hall, University of Delaware, Newark, DE 19717-1303. Specify bulletin 136, "Fencing For Horses."

Delaware residents can purchase the bulletin from county extension offices in Newark (451-2506), Dover (736-1448) and Georgetown (856-7303).
