

Nominate your top dairy individual

World Dairy Expo is seeking nominations of outstanding persons to be cited for their contributions to the dairy industry. The individuals selected will be honored at a Recognition Reception and Banquet scheduled for Tuesday, September 30th on the

grounds of the Dane County Exposition Center, Madison, Wisconsin.

For awards will again be presented.

One award is presented to the Man of the Year, who must be an active dairy farmer whose main

source of income is derived from the farm; the second to the Industry Person of the Year, who must be a salaried person paid by industry.

The third award goes to the National Dairy Woman. She must be an active partner in the farm

operation, with her selection based on contributions to the farm, family and community.

The fourth award category is International Person of the Year. Qualified individuals include dairy farmers or representatives of dairy industry from any country other than the United States who have contributed to dairy farming

or the dairy industry on an international level. Select Sires, Inc. and Harding & Harding, Inc. provide the award plaques signed by the President of the United States for each of the recipients. In addition, the National Dairy Woman receives a trip for herself and her husband to World Dairy Expo.

The National Dairy Woman program is sponsored annually by Associated Milk Producers, Inc., Mid-America Dairymen, Inc., Golden Guernsey Dairy Cooperative and The Swiss Valley Farm Dairymen.

Recognized in 1985 were EUGENE NELSON, Union Grove, Wisconsin, THOMAS L. LYON, Shawano, Wisconsin and DORIS HETTS, Ft. Atkinson, Wisconsin. All are active on state and national levels in promoting the dairy industry. DR. MARIA STOLZMAN, Warsaw, Poland was honored as the International Person of the Year.

Nominations for the 1986 awards must be postmarked by May 31, 1986. In order for the nominations to be accepted, they must be submitted on an official form which may be obtained by contacting World Dairy Expo at 2135 Rimrock Road, Madison, Wisconsin 53713, or by calling 608/251-3976.

World Dairy Expo is an international trade show for dairy farmers attracting nearly 90,000 visitors from across the United States and from as many as 54 countries. The show features national dairy cattle shows and judging contests, a Craft Forum, educational speakers and an extensive display of dairy equipment and technology by hundreds of local and national manufacturers. The 1986 show is scheduled for October 1 through 5 at the Dane County Exposition Center in Madison, Wisconsin.

Interested individuals are encouraged to pre-register. To obtain a registration form and copy of the program contact your local Penn State Cooperative Extension Office.

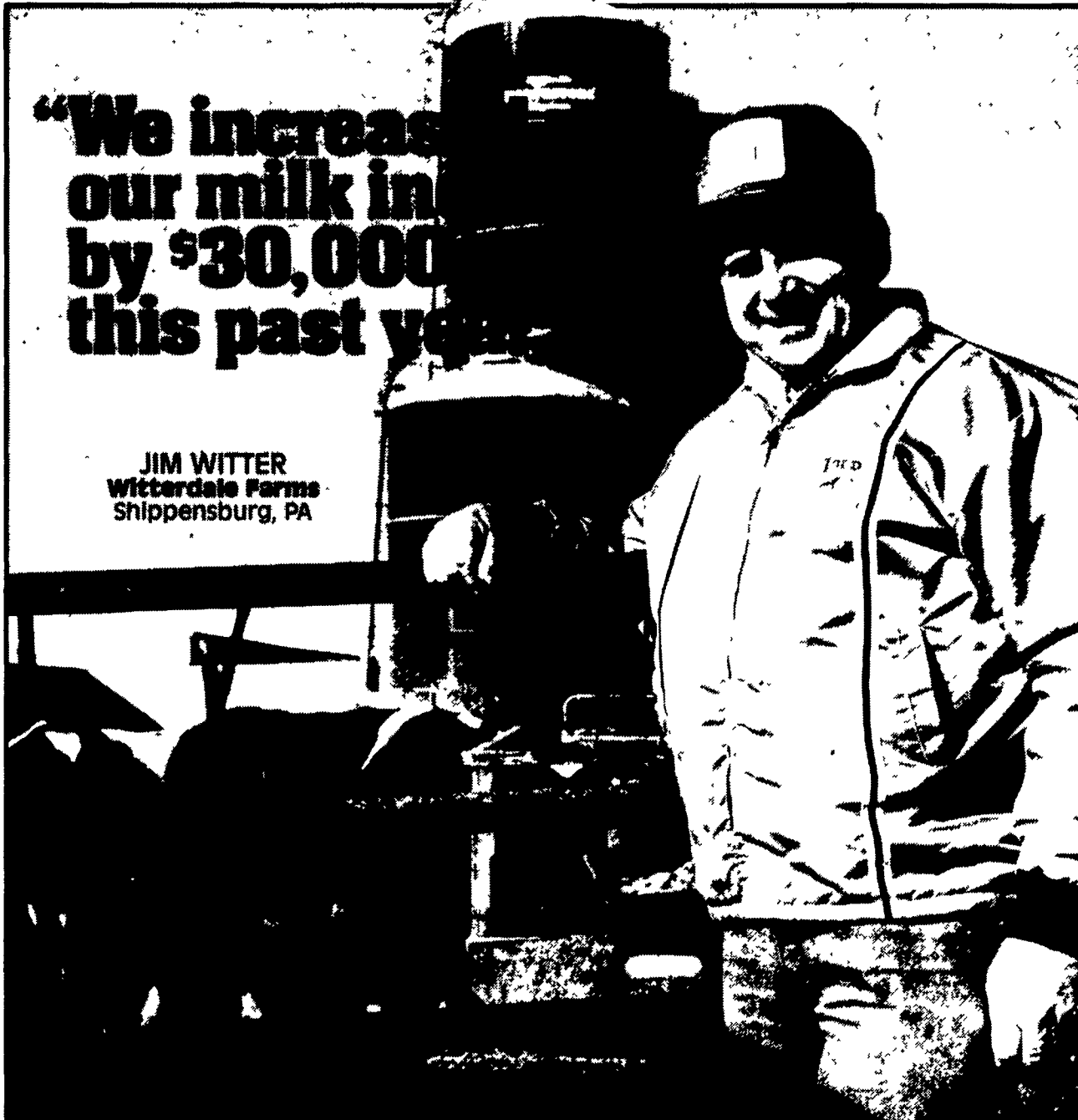
