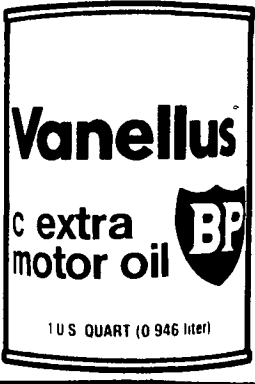
**UNIVERSITY PARK** - For the second year in a row, Somerset County has won top national honors for its outstanding 4-H safety program. This year's winning program is called "Kids in Safety Seats."  
 The program was awarded a share of General Motors stock from the General Motors Foundation which will be used to further the safety activities among 4-H'ers

in Somerset County. The County 4-H Council organized KISS in 1984 through a "Kids Concerned for Kids" campaign to inform 4-H families and the community about car seats and the car seat law that became effective January 1, 1985. Through radio commercials and newspaper articles, the public was made aware of the critical need for child safety in automobiles.

Since then, many 4-H meetings and demonstrations have been held and literature distributed pertaining to the law and types of infant seats available. More than \$1,300 has been raised to make rental seats available to parents who do not already have them. The seats are available for loan to the community through two local hospitals to encourage safety and compliance with the child car seat law.  
 Last year, the county won with a program focused on a Rabies Clinic Week. The Council was previously recognized for its KISS program by the PA Agricultural Safety Council in April of 1985 and the National Safety Council in February of this year.

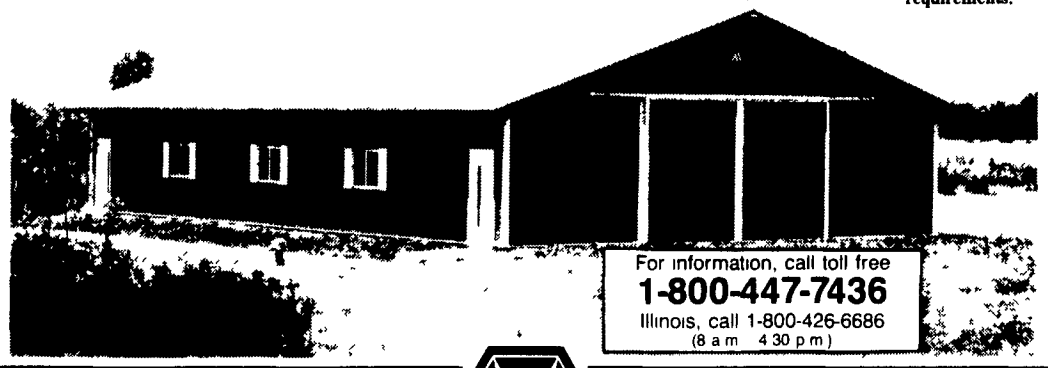
