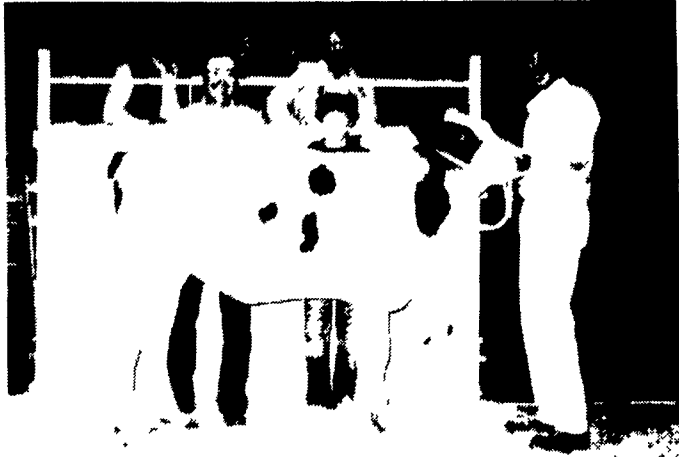

Middlebury receiving milk

SYRACUSE, NY — The Middlebury Center, Pa., milk manufacturing plant, leased by Northeast Dairy Cooperative Federation, Inc. to Dietrich's Milk Products, Inc., Reading, Pa., received milk on April 3 and started production on April 4, 1986. Plant operations and improvements are right on schedule according to Thomas Dietrich, vice president of Dietrich's.

The butter and whole milk powder manufacturing plant, although not running at full capacity yet, is receiving an

average of 250,000 pounds of milk a day and is operating five days a week. Thomas Decker, plant manager, stated that two shifts of 35 area people are currently employed at the plant.

United Dairy Cooperative Services, a division of Northeast Dairy Cooperative Federation, Inc., agent for supplying milk to Dietrich's, recently held two meetings in the Middlebury area to meet with interested milk producers, offering them opportunities for producer premiums and more favorable hauling rates.

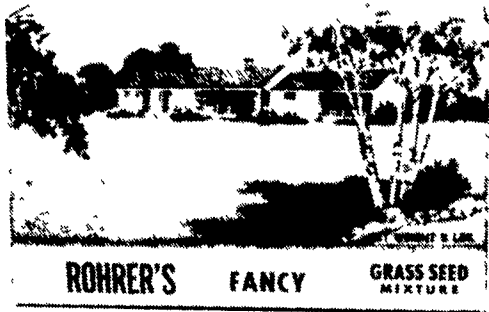

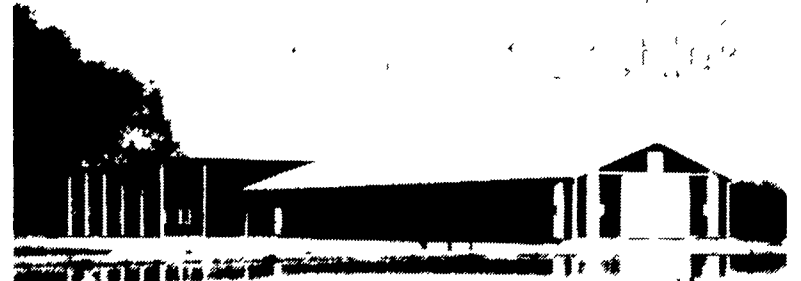

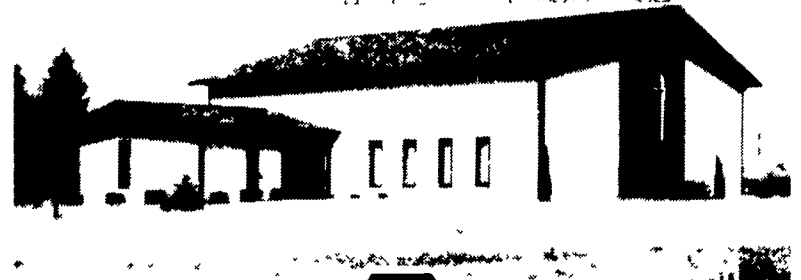
