LOCK HAVEN — Paul L Courter, RD#2, Mill Hall led the Clinton County Dairy Herd Improvement Association for December, 1985

The top herd in the Clinton County DHIA for December is owned by Paul L Courter, RD#2, Mill Hall, while the cow completing the highest lactation was owned by Ed & Norma Hayes, RD#1, Box 109, Mill Hall, PA 17751

The top herd of Registered Holsteins completed the month with a Rolling Herd Average of 18,366 pounds of milk per cow, yielding 694 pounds of butterfat

Other top herds were Richard L Schenck, RD#2, Box 500, Mill Hall, 17 960 pounds of milk, 665 pounds of butterfat

Tom & Grace Nicholas, RD#2, Loganton, 16,902 pounds of milk, 662 pounds of butterfat

Anthony & Caroline Graine, RD#1, Mill Hall, 19,409 pounds of milk, 655 pounds of butterfat

The cow completing the highest lactation of 305 days or less was R65, a 5 yr 11 mo old Registered Holstein owned by Ed & Norma Hayes, RD#1, Box 109, Mill Hall R65 produced 21,760 pounds of milk testing at 4 0 percent, yielding 879 pounds of butterfat in 305 days

Other top producing cows were Josie owned by Blair & Elaine Courter RD#2 Box 453 A Mill Hall, 19,987 pounds of milk 3 9 percent 786 pounds of butterfat

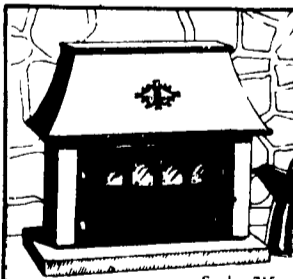
