

Major Dairy Sales And Dispersals Nationwide



Reports from seven sales for the week of May 2 to 8 showed 320 head averaging \$2,272.20. These sales were from Oregon to Oklahoma to Vermont. The top prices at the sales ranged from \$42,000 to \$702. Here is a brief look at the results of these sales.

AYRSHIRES

The 18TH EMPIRE STATE SPRING SALE held in New York averaged \$702.46 on 59 head. A bred heifer sired by Star Man topped the sale with the price of \$1,425. Second in the bidding was a first calf heifer by Bozo, selling for \$1,225.

The six cows averaged \$837.50 and the 10, first calf heifers averaged \$843. Tom Whittaker was the auctioneer.

JERSEY

The NEW ENGLAND JERSEY SPRING SALE averaged \$1,550 on 42 head. A 3-year-old sired by Milestone Generator topped this sale with a price of \$4,100. Second in the bidding was a 2-year old Canadian consignment. This Bonnie Burn Doris Paragon daughter sold for \$2,500.

The GOLDEN BONUS SALE held in connection with this averaged \$925 on six calves. The highest price calf was sired by Quicksilver Magic of Ogston and sold for \$1,550.

Auctioneers for the day were C.W. Gray and Sons.

GUERNSEY

The WESTERN GUERNSEY SIRE SALE in Oregon averaged \$856.58 on 19 head. The top two selling entries were 2-year olds sired by Welcome Choice Admiral. The highest price was \$1,700 followed by \$1,450.

In their youth sale, the high price was \$900 on an 8 month old daughter of Wincrest Volcano. This sale averaged \$418 on 15 head.

The OKLAHOMA STATE SALE averaged \$1,038 on 34 head. A junior yearling by Raemelon Deacon Fashion topped the sale with the price of \$1,800. Second in the bidding was a 2-year old sired by Welcome Choice Admiral, selling for \$1,750. She was followed by a 2-year-old daughter of Lone Palm Telesar Judilee with the price of \$1,700.

The six cows in this sale averaged \$1,331. Gary Estes of Missouri served as the auctioneer

and Ernest Berousek read pedigrees for this sale.

HOLSTEIN

The FOCUS ON GENETICS INVITATIONAL SALE held in Illinois averaged \$8,833.66 on 66 head. This sale was topped by a 3-year old Valiant daughter. Included in her selling price of \$42,000 was a contract on the calf she is carrying. This cow also has

two records over 25,000 pounds of milk.

Second high in the bidding was a price of \$39,000 on a 3-year old sired by Cal Clark Cutlass. Another 3-year old sold for \$33,000 and was sired by Carlin M Ivanhoe Bell.

All the cows sold were classified very good or excellent. The auctioneering firm of Burton and Fellers managed the sale.

The RANDELL DAIRY INC. DISPERSAL averaged \$2,000 on 94 head. The 5-year old daughter by Conductor topped the sale with a price of \$12,700. This cow, classified excellent, produced a 4-year old record of 33,670 pounds of milk. This sale was managed by Southern Holstein Marketing and McIntyre and Wiley. Auctioneers were Marvin McIntyre and Elvin Yoder.

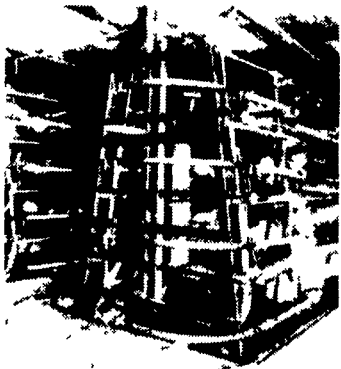
