The theme for the 1986 State Project is Pennsylvania commodities. All projects must be made from a Pennsylvania product.

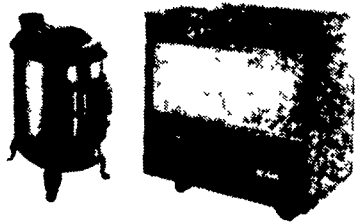

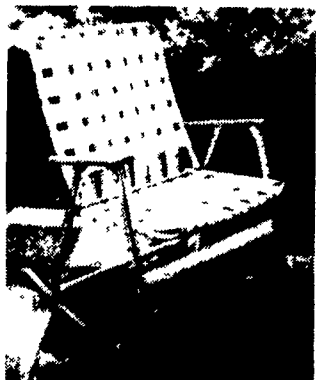

High Back Rocker

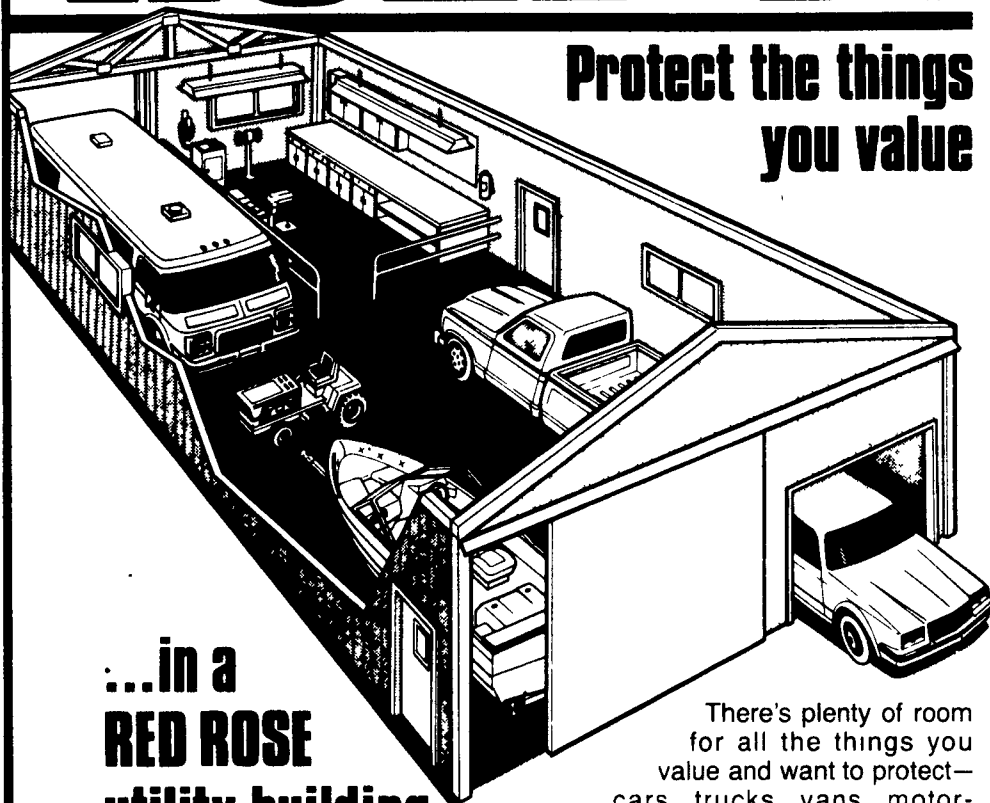
