## Annville Cleona FFA Tops Regional Speaking Contest

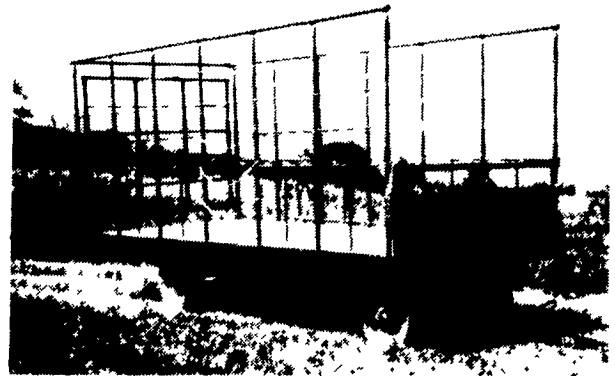
The Annville Cleona Little Dutchmen parliamentary procedure team captured first place in the regional speaking contest held recently at Kutztown High School.
