will be resurveyed," he said. "Then formal deed restrictions will be placed on the property. And finally the land will be sold in the fall of 1986 by sealed bid. This is the first time we will have nine new protected adjoining farms on the market," Musselman said. "This represents the second largest tract of land under preservation in Pennsylvania."

An upbeat attitude was projected at the conference as the panel members lauded the move by the Pennsylvania utility. County Commissioner Chairman, James Huber, used the term exhilarating to describe the announcement. Amos Funk, chairman of the Agricultural Preserve Board, joined his fellow neighbors in saying ''Hallelujah''. Ed Goodhart, Manor Township supervisor, expressed appreciation for the move after years of "Wondering what was going on down there along the river?

The tracts of land consisting of about 80 percent highly productive Class I, II and III soils are located between Washington Boro and Cresswell in an area of very productive farm land near the Susquehanna River. The move is




