While a student at Northeastern High School, she was a member of the National Honor Society, marching and concert bands, drama club, senior class play and musicals.

In appreciation for her activities as the 1985 princess, Joyce Ruppert received a standing ovation from the audience of dairy farm and industry representatives. During her reign she made more than 80 appearances, including presentations to over 1,000 school children.

New princess Deborah Kann will be participating in several June Dairy Month activities.
