

# Becky Alpaugh to Represent Hunterdon Co. Dairymen as Dairy Princess

RINGOES — Becky Alpaugh, 17, of Alexandria Township was selected Hunterdon County's Dairy Princess last week, earning the right to promote dairy products

around the county and to compete in a statewide dairy princess competition.

Becky, the daughter of Carmen and Helen Alpaugh of SchAAF Road, is a junior at Delaware Valley High School, where she is a member of the National Honor

Society and the Key Club.

She is also active in 4-H dairy and square dance clubs, a volunteer at Warren Hospital in Phillsburg and a member of the Bloomsburg Clown Club.

Becky was raised on her family's 115-acre dairy farm, where they milk about 40 Holstein and Ayrshire cows and another 20 head of young stock are maintained.

She hopes to pursue a career in nursing, possibly with an emphasis

on midwifery.

Both she and Robin Hoffman, 16, of Tewksbury Township, her alternate, performed skits with hand puppets of cartoon-character cows, explaining to a young audience the importance of Real milk products.

Robin, the daughter of Robert and Dorothy Hoffman of Route 512 near Califon, helps out with the family's 15 Brown Swiss cows and on the 192-acre crop farm.

She is the secretary of the Hunterdon County 4-H Dairy Council, serves as vice president of the Voorhees High School Future Farmers of America chapter and is the president of her 4-H Dairy Club.

Becky succeeds Gretchen Kuehn of Raritan Township as the dairy princess. The crowning came at dairy farm open house at Charles Rogers' Penn Breeze Farm on Everitts Road.



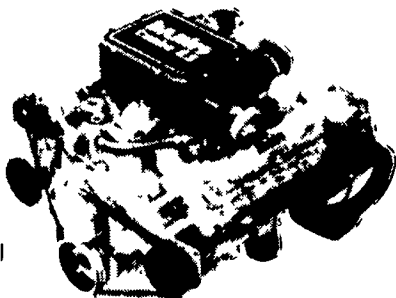
