nesday. Slaughter bulls scarce. Slaughter supply mainly choice and prime mixed good and choice steers and heifers, around 15% cows.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and large frame 1: 300-500 lbs. 51.00-54.50; 500-700 lbs. 51.00-53.75.

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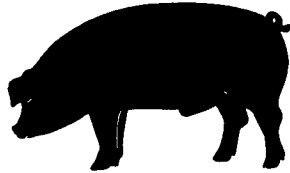
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
