When eating a food as delicious as ice cream, one is not likely to think of its nutritional value. Yet, 1 1/2 cups of ice cream will contribute the same amount of calcium to the diet as one eight-ounce cup of milk.

If your favorite ice cream pie recipe calls for "softened" ice cream, remove it from the freezer and place on the refrigerator shelf for about one-half hour. This way it will soften evenly rather than melting on the outside while the inside remains firm.

Another tasty way to get your calcium is to use 1/2 cup of ice cream with 1/2 cup milk in a milkshake and you'll have the equivalent of a cup of milk.

Ten percent of the total milk produced in the U.S. is used in ice cream products.



BALE ELEVATORS

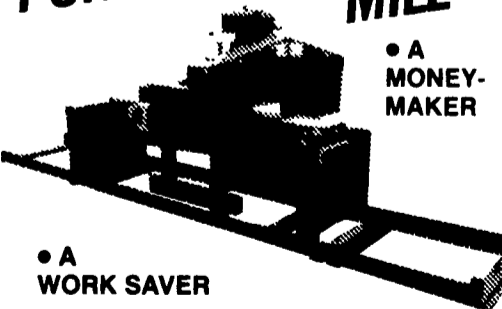
Sturdy square tube construction. Basic 16' unit is sectional so that other sections can be inserted for greater lengths.
