Sheppard will also be on the agenda.

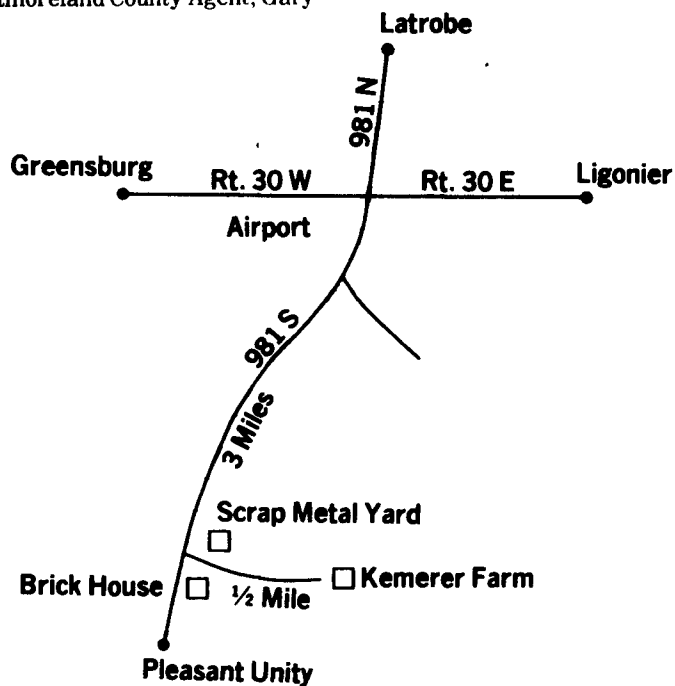
Following a luncheon, a short business meeting will be held and production awards will be given.

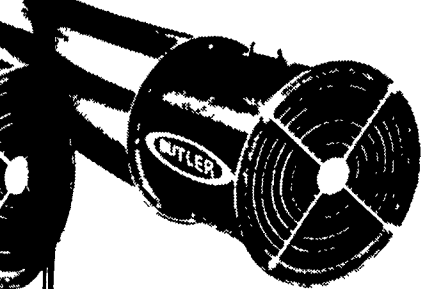

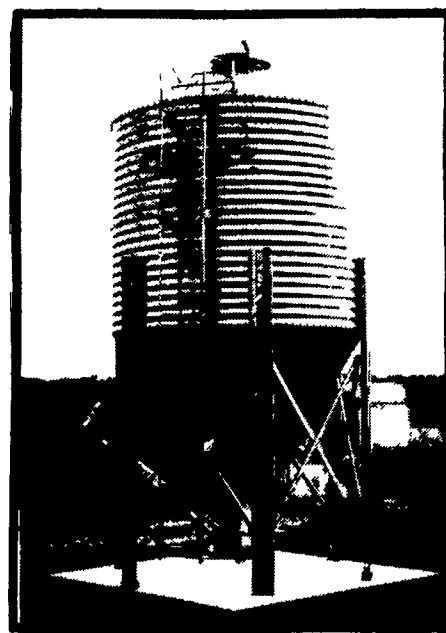
